Members attending were entered into a raffle, and four members won Visa gift cards, which were mailed to the winners. We sincerely thank all of those who took part in the meeting!



Check out some information we shared at the meeting below. Here's how we compare to our peers regarding fee income and dividends paid to members:




Based on average assets of \$248 mm:
